Coach Requirements

- Completed Police Record Check – requirement for all coaches working with youth
- Completed Sport Canada's Safe Sport & World Rugby's Concussion Awareness modules
- Certified in NCCP Competition Development (Head Coaches: Level 2 certified or Level 2 trained and awaiting assessment for completing certification)
- A minimum of two years' Coaching experience at Club/School/University/Rep levels

Key Responsibilities

- Lead in talent identification and player selection
- Lead in the development of players and foster an environment that aligns with the five values of World Rugby: respect, integrity, solidarity, passion and discipline
- Effective co-ordination and communication of game preparation and implementation, as well as a knowledge and understanding of in-game adjustments and facilitating them during competition
- Provide appropriate guidance and feedback before, during and after games relative to team performance
- Advocate on behalf of the players promoting their ability to be selected for higher honours where appropriate

- Excellent leadership and organizational skills
 - Exemplary communication and interpersonal skills are critical for success in this role
 - Strong technical and tactical 7s expertise and teaching ability
 - Ability to select quality rugby players that have the skill to be successful at the rep level
