Women's Head Coach – Responsibilities

- Attend all Board meetings.
- Provide individual player development profiles and player feedback as required
- Other duties as required.
- Knowledge and experience at managing assistant coaches and working cooperatively with the Board of Directors and team medical staff.
- Ability to work extended hours, evenings and weekends.

Qualifications required

- World Rugby/NCCP Level 2 Certified
- Minimum of 3 years of Senior Women coaching experience
- Competency playing or coaching at high level of senior rugby
